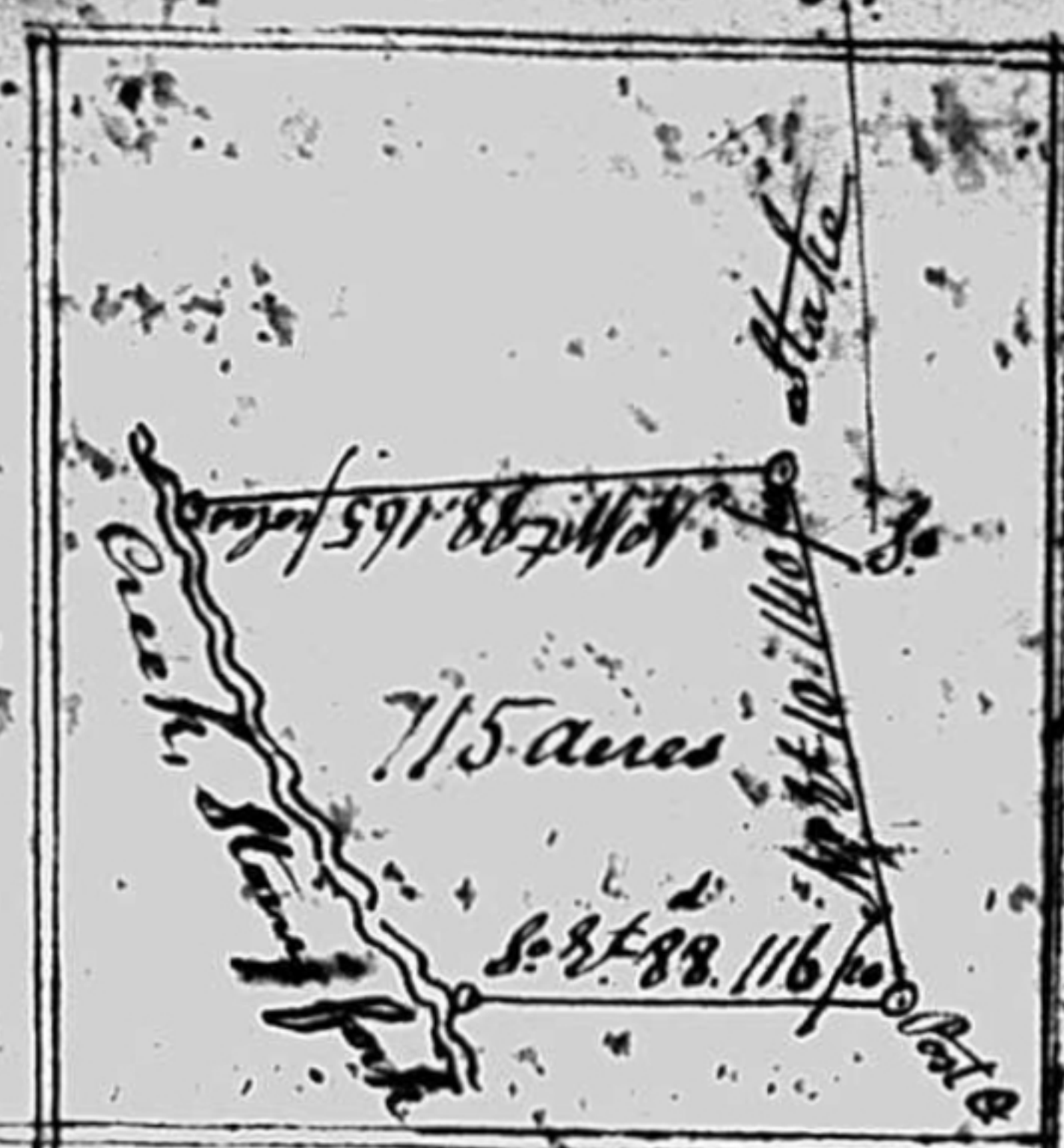




South Carolina, Laurens County  
 Resurveyed a tract of land  
 containing one hundred and  
 fifteen Acres for James Williamson  
 the same being part of a tract  
 of Kuykendall, Situate, lying  
 and being on the Beckys fork  
 of Fishing Creek; on the East side

of Creek, Beginning at a Stake at the Creek  
 and runs S. 8. 88. 116 poles to a Post Oak, thence  
 North West 10. 140 poles to a Stake, thence North  
 West 88. 165 poles to the Creek, thence with the  
 Creek the several courses to the beginning, bound-  
 ing on John Moores Land, South West on Oag  
 North on John Williamson, and hath such shapes  
 and marks as the above Plat describes. —

 Know all men by these presents, that I John McLean of  
 the District of York and State of South Carolina aforesaid  
 Clerk, for and in consideration of three hundred and thirty  
 nine Dollars, have granted, bargained, sold, and released  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
 unto William Martin of the State and District aforesaid  
 a certain tract of Land, situate in the District and State  
 aforesaid, on the North fork of Fishing Creek, joining my own  
 George Davis and Hugh Berry's Lands, beginning at an Ash  
 on the bank of the Creek, and running down the same the  
 various courses about 22 poles to a small Post Oak, thence
