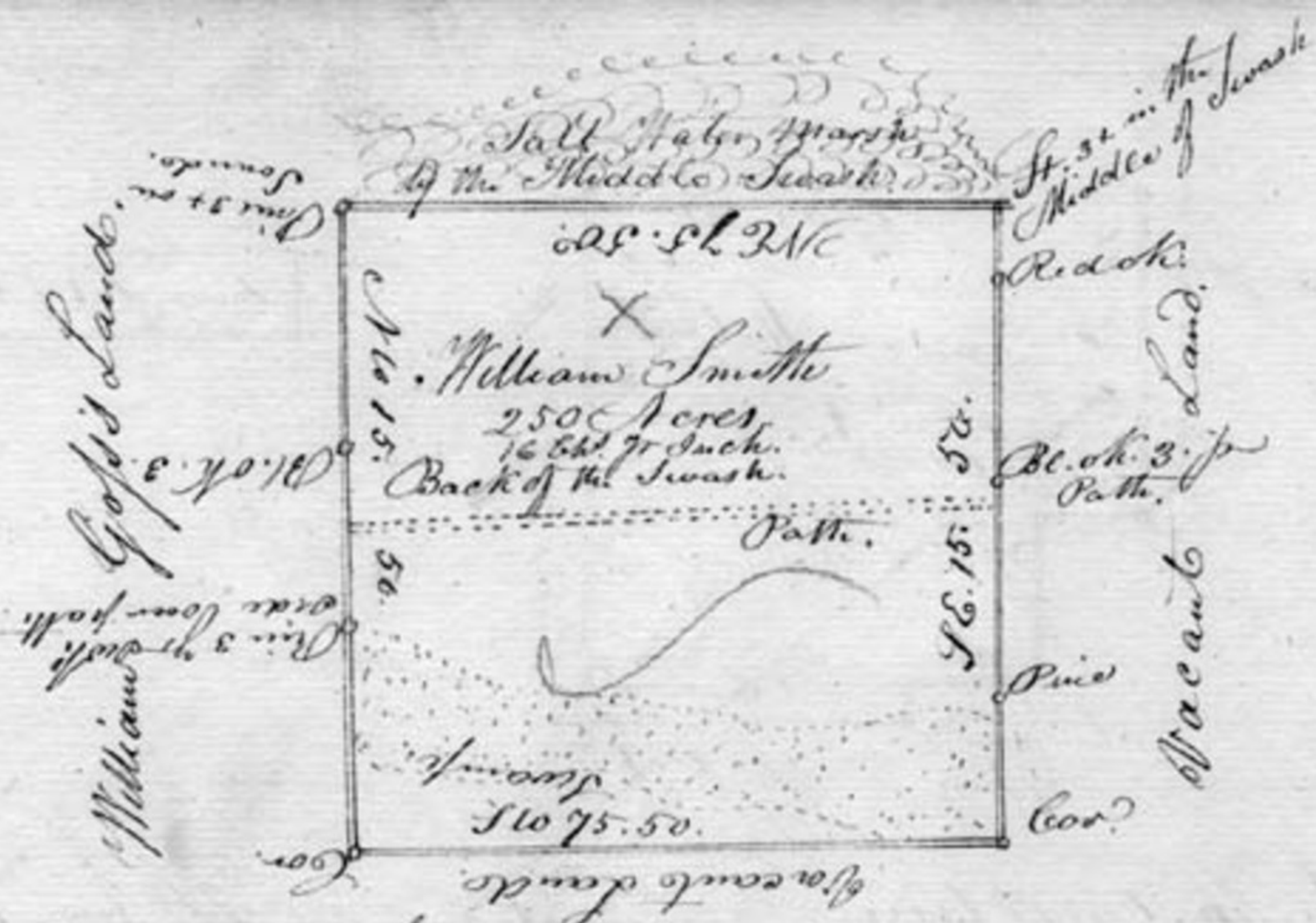




South Carolina.

By virtue of a precept from James St. John Esq., Surveyor General, and dated the 14th day of March 1736, I have admeasured and laid out to William Smith a plantation or tract of land containing two hundred and fifty acres, on back of the Middle Swash, on Long Bay, in Prince George Parish, Craven County: And putting and bounding to the S.E. on Salt Water Marsh, and to the N.E. on William Goff's land, and to the N.W. of S.W. on vacant land: And hath such shape and form and marked trees as are described in the above delineated plate of the same. Witness and returned this 31st of Oct: 1739

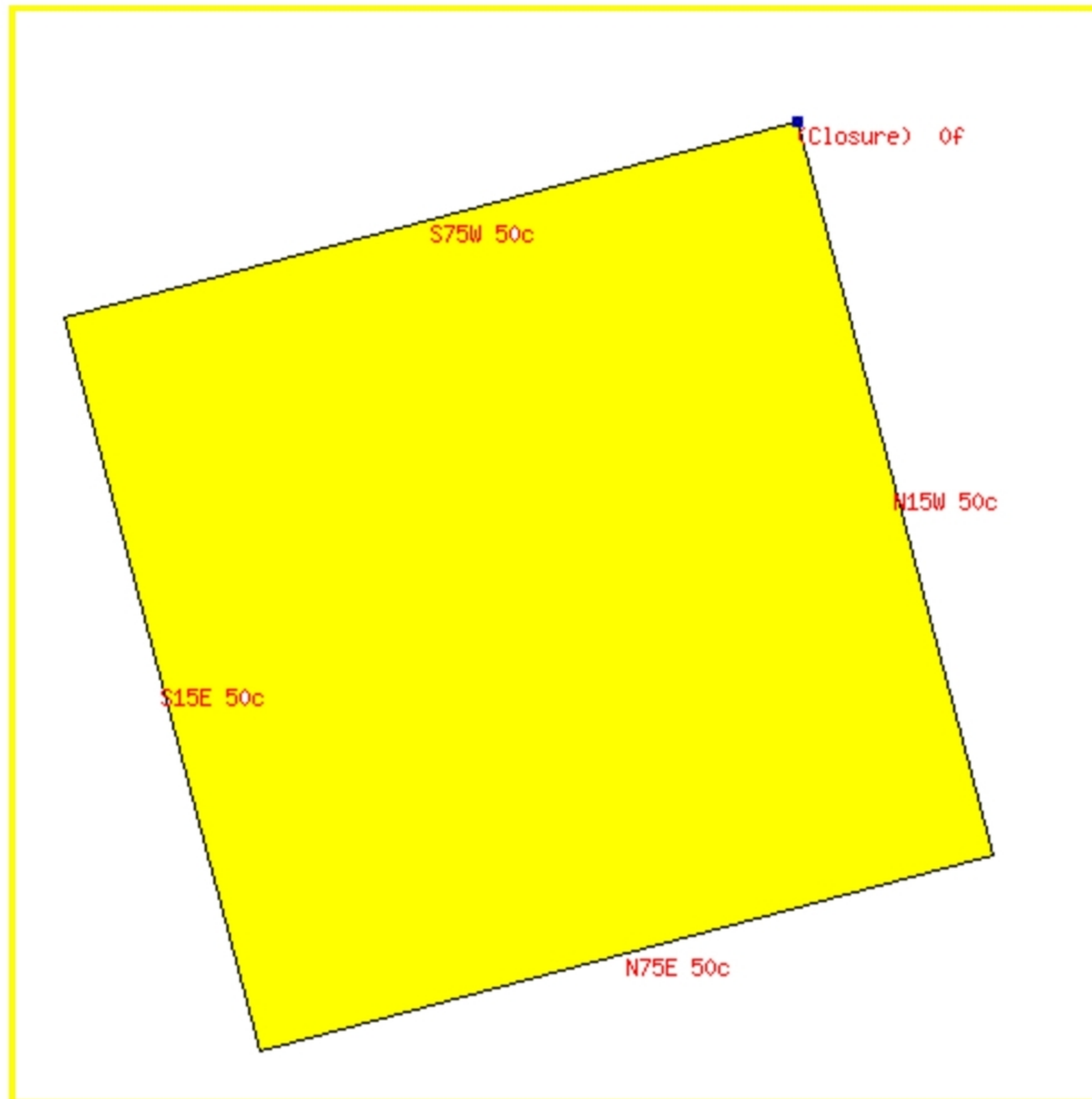
