Cannon to Briant Release

South Carolina. This Indenture made this the second day of January in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred & Eighty nine & in the fourteenth year of Independence in America. Between Henry Cannon of the State of South Carolina and Cheraw District Darlington County of the one Part & William Briant of the same place of the other Part, Witnesseth, That whereas Thomas Pinkney Governor did give and grant unto Henry Cannon a Plantation or Tract of Land containing one Thousand Acres Situate on Palmeto Branch Waters of High Hill Creek dated the sixth of August one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven now this Indenture Witnesseth, That Henry Cannon for and in consideration of the sum of two pounds Current money of South Carolina to him in hand paid by the said by the said William Briant at and before the Sealing & delivering of these Presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be fully satisfied & Contented and paid. Have granted Bargained sold Released & confirmed & by these Presents do grant & Bargain & sell alien. Release & confirm unto the said William Briant, in his Actual Possession now being by virtue of a Bargain & Sale to him thereof made for one whole year & by force of the Statute for transferring uses into Possession & to his Heirs and assigns forever all that part

of Tract of land from a So East Pine corner of a fifty acre tract said William Briant land & from there a straight line with said Briant's South East line to where it will cross Daniel Polk's line bounded Eastward by Edwards Coopers land Westward & Northward by said Briant's land & Southwardly by Polk land there being Ten Acres more or less with all & singular The Houses building yards, Gardens, Orchards, Timber & Timber Trees Water & Water courses profits and Commodities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining with all the Profits thereof thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To Have & to Occupy the said plantation or Tract of land containing ten Acres be the same more or less with all its appurtenances. Per in before Granted Released and conveyed unto the said William Briant his heirs & Assigns forever to the only use and behoof of him the said William Briant his heirs and assigns and also that it shall be lawful for him the said William Briant his heirs and assigns from time to time & all times hereafter to Hold and Occupy the said plantation or Tract of land containing ten Acres more or less with every of its Appurtenances & that without Molestation or Denial of him the said Henry Cannon or his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns and that free from all manner of incumbrance the Taxes only excepted: And Lastly the said Henry Cannon for himself his heirs Administrators & Assigns the said Tract of Land containing ten Acres more or less with all its appurtenances unto the said William Briant his heirs & Assigns & against the lawful claim or Claims of all or every other Person or Persons whatsoever, shall and will forever. Warrant and defend by these Presents In Witness whereof the said Henry Cannon have hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written
