I know all men by these presents that I Matthew
McBrought of Faberula County and State aforesaid
for and in Consideration of fifteen pounds to me paid
by William Bryant of the County and State aforesaid
planter have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release
unto the said William Bryant all that plantation
or tract of land containing one hundred ~~and~~ and
two acres situate in fork of Dutchmans creek bounded
by land formerly belonging to James Hardage Nathaniel
Ford James Porter and Thomas Meredith and hath such
form and shape as appears by a plat annexed to the
original grant. Together with all and singular the
right members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said William
Bryant his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said William Bryant his heirs and assigns
myself and my heirs and assigns against every person whom
Power lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this
fifteenth day of November in the year of our Lord
1795 and in the nineteenth year of American Inde
pendence
