and by these presents do grant bargain and release unto
the said Canon Cason one hundred Acres be it more or
less beginning at a pine and running a West Course to John
Britneys Land cornering on a black Oak thence N.E. to Canon
Casons Land surveyed him the said William Bryan on the
10th Day of November 1796, situate in the District of Camden
on the drains of Dutchmans Creek and Waters of the Water
Priver together with all and singular the rights Mem-
bers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said pre-
mises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Canon Cason his heirs and assigns
