Know ye that I the said Lewis Bryant of the State of Georgia Bryar Creek planter for and in consideration of the love good will, and affection I have and do bear towards my loving Daughter Susanna Bryant daughter of my first wife Mary Bryant of the County of Kerrhaw in the state of South Carolina Infinit have given and granted and by these presents do freely give and grant unto the s^a Susanna Bryant her heirs executors or administrators all and singular the land and cattle under named that is to say two hundred acres of Land lying and being in the District of Camden in the County of Kerrhaw on a place called the Lake bay and joining land laid out for Ruben Cook and land laid out for James Sowel including the Dog Fenel Bottom and being the lower end of a tract of Land containing six hundred acres of Land given to Lewis Franklin Bryant by deed of grant given to the afores^d. Lewis Bryant with four head of Cattle now in the possession of Solomon Abel marked thus A smooth crop in the left ear and half crop on the upper side of the right ear which I have given and do give unto my afores^d. daughter Susanna Bryant and her heirs for ever, To have and to hold all the afores^d. Land containing two hundred acres of Land with the afores^d. cattle to her the s^a Susanna Bryant her heirs executors or administrators from hence forth as her and their proper land and cattle absolutely without any manner of condition. In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and seal this 16th day of August, One thousand seven hundred and ninety nine
