one thousand seven hundred of Eighty six of is the same whereon the said
James Underwood now lives and hath such shape form and marks
as will no more fully appear by a plat annexed to the Original grant
Together with all and singular the Rights members and Appurtenances
Whosoever to the said tract of one hundred of Eighty four acres of land
belonging or in anywise appertaining & the Reversion and Reversion
Remainder and Remainders thereof To have and To hold the S^c.
of one hundred of Eighty four acres of land and premises hereby bargained
of sold or meant and intended to be bargained of sold unto the said
