that I Isaac Bryan of Robeson
County in the State of North Carolina (Carpenter) in consider-
ation of the sum of one Hundred dollars to me paid by antho-
ny Bryan Brysson of Marion District in the State of
South Carolina (planter) have granted bargain sold & released
& by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the
S^r Anthony Brysson all that tract or plantation of land con-
taining five hundred acres be the same more or less situated in
S^d district on gum swamp a branch of catfish creek waters
of great pee die river Originally granted to the S^r Bryan
the 7th day November A.D. 1796 having such form & marks
as are represented by a plat of the same annexed to the said origi-
nal grant together with all & singular the rights, members
incumbrances & appurtenances to the S^d premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining.

To have & to hold all & singular the said premises unto
him the S^d Anthony Brisson his heirs & assigns for ever
and I do hereby bind myself & my heirs, Executors & administrators
to warrant & defend ~~and~~ all & singular the S^d premises against
myself my heirs forever in witness whereof I have here unto
set my hand this twenty fourth day of February in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & six
& in the thirtieth year of the independence of the united
States of America.
