 Seventy dollars to me in hand paid by William Bryan
 of State and District aforesaid and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell make over and release
 unto the said William Bryan all and singular
 a plantation or tract of land containing one
 hundred acres more or less situated in said District lying
 on the N.W. side of the Sand Hill Bay adjacent to
 the original Plat its being a tract of land granted
 to Barnabas Watson to John Smith and conveyed
 from John Smith to Jesse Bryan. Together with all and
 singular rights Member and Accretions & appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said William Bryan
 his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind
 myself my heirs Executors administrators or assigns to com-
 -rants and forever defend all and singular the
 said premises unto the said William Bryan his heirs and
 assigns against myself and my heirs and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof as Witness My hand & Seal 6 Dec 1800
