Nathan Bryant all that plantation or tract of land containing twenty acres more or less being part of a tract of land on the head of Beaversdam Creek supposed to have been granted to John Hunter and sold by him to Michael Risen and by him to my father (James Farmer) beginning at Nathan Bryants Run Corner near the Creek from thence to a State Corner in Nathan Bryants land thence to where Farmers upper line crosses the Creek thence down the meander of the Creek to the beginning so as to include all that part of the said tract which lays on the east side of the Creek together with all and singular the rights members Tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Nathan Bryant his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs and against every other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
