Know all men by these presents, that Henry Siles of the State and District aforesaid, have this day bargained sold and released unto J. M. Brian of the same State and District aforesaid, all that piece or parcel of land, in which E. O. Clement now lives, situated on the South side of South Pacolet River, waters of Broad River, for the sum of Fourteen Hundred dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the hand of the above named J. M. Brian, bounded as follows: Beginning at a White Oak, on the North bank of said river, running thence South with B. Clark's line 12.40 to P.O. 3x3x dead, Clark's corner, thence S. 35 1/2 W 16.90 to P.O. 3x3x at Miller's Gap road, thence S 12 W with said road, thence 7.21 to a stone in road, thence S 78 1/2 E 9.00 to a rock, thence S. 76 1/2 E. 4.58 to a Chestnut stump, near an old Spring, thence N 6. E 4.00 to a stake in the branch, thence about 3.50 to a Persimmon, thence N 80 W 1.07 to a stone in place of P.O. gone, thence N 31. E 14.90 to a stone, thence thence of 52 E. 5.50 to a rock, thence S. 78 E to the branch, thence down said branch to the river, thence up the meanders of the river to the beginning, containing Two Hundred acres more or less. To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid premises and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise incident unto the above mentioned J. M. Brian his heirs and assigns; and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to forever defend unto the above named J. M.
