Spartanburg County:

I now all men by these presents, that I, Henry Siles of the State and District aforesaid, have this day bargained sold and released unto J. M. Brian of the same State and District aforesaid, all that piece or parcel of land, on which E. O. Clement now lives, situated on the South side of South Pacolet river, water of Broad river, for the sum of Fourteen hundred dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the hand of the abovesigned J. M. Brian, bounded as follows: Beginning at a White oak, on the South bank of said river, running thence South with B. Clark's line 12. 40 to B.D. 3x3x dead, Clark's corner, thence S. 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 18. 90 to P.O. 3x3x at Mill's Gap road, thence S 12 W with said road, thence 7. 21 to a stone in road, thence S 78 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 9. 00 to a rock, thence S. 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4. 58 to a Chestnut stump, near an old spring, thence N 6. 8 4. 00 to a stake on the branch, thence about 3. 00 to a Persimmon, thence N 80 W 107 to a stone in place of M.S. gone, thence N 31. 6 14. 90 to a stone, thence thence S. 52 E. 5. 00 to a rock; thence S. 76 E to the branch, thence down said branch to the river, thence up the meander of the river to the beginning, containing two hundred acres more or less. To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid premises and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise incident unto the abovesigned J. M. Brian his heirs and assigns; and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to forever defend unto the above named J. M. Brian, his heirs, executors and assigns, and from any person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof given under my hand and seal this the 27th day of September 1867, signed, sealed, & delivered

Know all men by these presents, that I, Thomas M. Shields, Executor of the estate of Thomas A. Shields, deceased, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
and fifty one dollars, to me in hand paid by M. P. Finger and by
virtue of authority given me in a will of Thomas A. Shields I do
in the State aforesaid, I have granted, bargained, sold and released
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
M. P. Finger, of the same State and County, a certain Lot or parcel of
land, designated as Lot No 2, lying in Spartanburg County, on both
sides of Buck creek, waters of Pacolet river, bounded by Lot No 1, belonging
to the widow, and by Robbin, Finger, Ramsey and others, beginning
on a N. 0. on a ridge road, thence N 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 21.50 to 80 3x m w. at the
mouth of lane near stable; thence N 42 E. 42.45 to a Water 0 340m
Robbin corner; thence S. 31 E. 12.00 to fignum 38 om, thence down the
