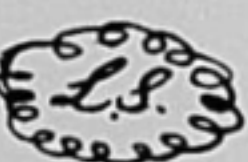


319. *Thomson B. Collins.* South Carolina. Know all men

7th. April 1834. South Carolina, and Union District. for
and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged by H. H. Thomson of the state aforesaid; and the District of Spartanburgh,
have granted, bargained, sold and delivered; and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver
to the said H. H. Thomson a certain parcel or Lot of land, lying and being in the Village of Spar-
tanburgh being Lot N. 19. on the plan of the lots laid out for said Village, bounded as follows,
beginning on a stone, on the south side of the Publick Square at a cross street, that runs to the Sail
and on the line of said square, and runs south 54 W 1 chain 58 links to a stone on the line of the Pub-
lic Square, thence S 25 E 3 chs 16 links to a stone - thence N 54 E 1 ch 58 links to a stone, on a cross
street - thence N. 25 W along said cross street 3 chs. 16 links to the beginning, containing one half acre
more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members and hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurtenant. To Have & To Hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said H. H. Thomson his heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and assigns to forever defend the same with

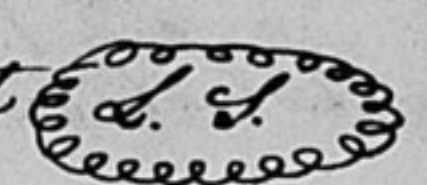
