Thirtieth day of March and in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety one in fifteenth of the Independence of America Between William Bryant of the County of Union and State aforesaid of the one part and Abiah Howard of the State and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesses that the said William Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of Five pound Sterling money to him in hand paid by the same Abiah Howard the Receipt of which is hereby Acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and aliened released conveyed and confirmed a tract or parcel of Land Containing Three Acres more or less Beginning at Philip Bryants South west Corner on a pine which is Wm. Brownings Corner Running near East Course to Black Oak Corner Thence to a post Oak corner Thence to Corner on a Stake on Philip Bryants line and Archer Howard line it being part of a tract of land granted to Philip Bryant by William Bull Esquire Governor the fifth of May one thousand seven hundred and Twenty nine with every appurtenance belonging or in any wise appertaining. Thence to the said Abiah Howard his heirs executors administrators or assigns forever and the said William Bryant doth hereby Covenant grant and agree to and with the said Abiah Howard in Manner and form following that is to say that the said William Bryant and his heirs shall and will warrant and defend the above premises to the said Abiah Howard his heirs and assigns from and Against all persons whatsoever. hundred and Ninety one and in the sovereignty and
Independence of the United States of America the Sixteenth
Between Bernard Glenn of the State of South Carolina
and County of Union of the one part, And Joseph Coleman
of the State and County of Union of the other part. Witnesseth
that the said Bernard Glenn for and in consideration of
the sum of Two hundred and Thirteen pounds Sterling to
him in hand paid by the said Joseph Coleman the receipt
whereof he doth hereby confess, and acknowledge, hath
Granted bargained and sold, and by these presents, doth
bargain and sell, unto the said Joseph Coleman his heirs
and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land
situate in the State aforesaid and County of Union lying
and being on the South side of Broad river. Beginning
at a White Oak 38 on the bank of broad river and running
thence North Eighty nine degrees West fifty four Chains
to a Hickory 38 bounded by James Glenns land, Thence
North Six degrees East fifty six Chains and sixty links
to a Stake 38 thence South Eighty East forty Chains to a white
Oak 38 on the bank of broad river thence down the various
courses of said river to the beginning containing Two hundred
and Fifty five acres of land be the same more or less it
being part of a larger tract of Six hundred acres of land originally
Granted to William Love on the third day of September 1753
and sold by John Lovi heir at Law of the said William
to Elias Hollingsworth Esquire. and by said Hollingsworth
to Bernard Glenn which will more fully appear reference
to be had from the records Together with all and singular
the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise apper-
taining to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
land, unto the said Joseph Coleman his heirs and assigns
forever
