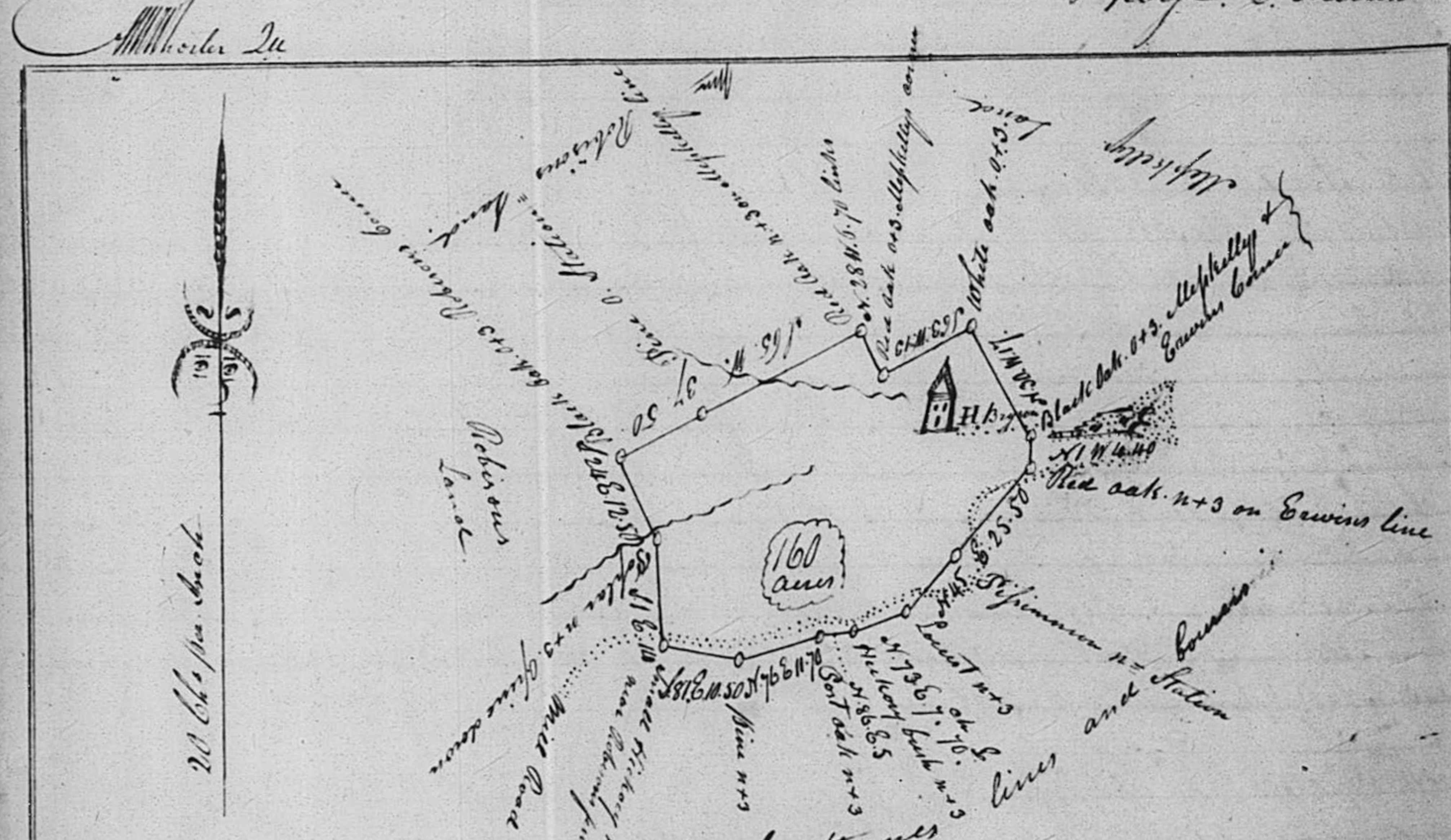
Know all men by these presents that I George Rop of York District and State aforesaid in consideration of Four Hundred dollars to me paid by John Brison of the District and State aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and release unto the said John Brison all that Tract or parcel of Land whereon Hugh Brison now lives lying and being in the District of York aforesaid on the Waters off Turkey Creek and part of a Tract Originally Granted to Andrew Tipping September Second One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Three and late belonging to the Estate of John Turner Deceased Beginning at a Black Oak Alleykelly & Ewens corner running thence S. 30. W. 17. to a White Oak thence S. 63. W. 13 to a Black Oak thence N. 28. W. 6. 70. to a Red Oak on Alleykelly line thence S. 6. W. 37. 50 to a black Oak Robisons corner thence S. 24. E. 12. 50 to a Poplar thence S. 1. E. 10 to a Hickory thence S. 81. E. 10. 50 to a pine thence N. 70. E. 11. 50 to a Post Oak thence N. 86. E. to a Hickory bush thence N. 73. E. 7. 70. to a locust. thence N. 45. E. 25. 50. to a Red Oak thence to the Beginning as will more fully appear by a plat of survey made by Daniel M. Elledge May 30th 1823 reference being thereto had containing One Hundred and sixty Acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise Incident or Appertaining. To Have and to hold all and singular the said mentioned premises unto the said John Brison his Heirs and assigns forever And I the said George Rop do hereby Warrant and defend the above mentioned premises to the said John Brison his Heirs and assigns against my self my Heirs Executors and Administrators and against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof I the said George Rop have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty ninth day of July in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight Hundred and Thirty and in the fifty four year of American Independence

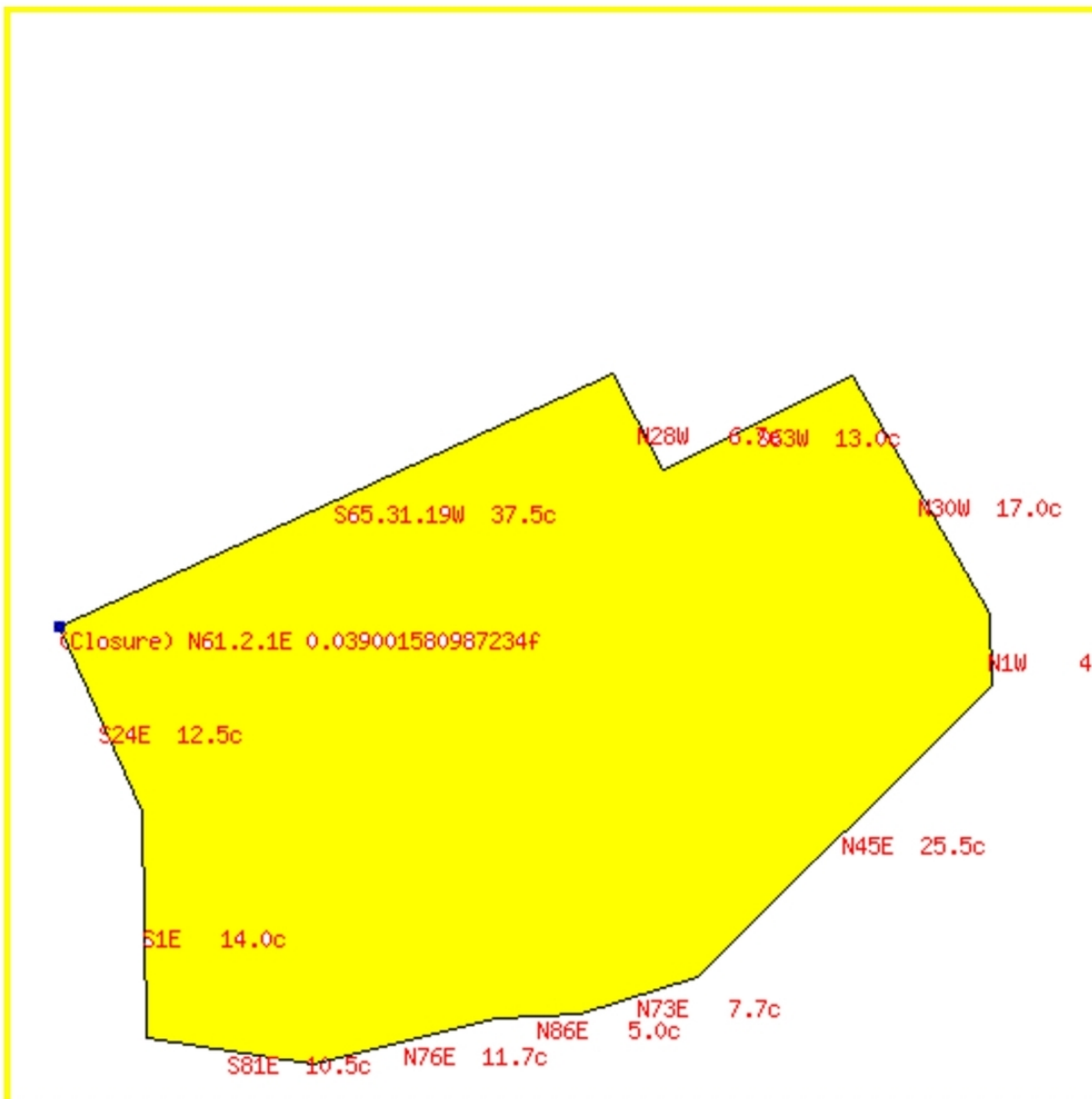
