and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said William Youngblood a tract of land situate in York District
and State aforesaid on the branches of Allifours Creek waters of
Calabaw River beginning at a post oak Barnhills corner and run N
89° E 21.50 to a pine thence N 80° E 47.00 to a post oak thence S 0
21° E 60.00 to a forked Spanish oak thence S 37° W 30 to a Hickory
thence N 75° W 2.50 to a black oak thence N 2° E 7.50 to a P.O.
thence N 78° W 35 to a chestnut thence N 66° E 27.00 to a post
oak thence N 38° W 33.50 to the beginning containing 469 acres
be the same more or less granted to the said William Ed.
Hayne December 11th 1813. Recorded in Grant Book G N 7.
page 352. Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises be-
longing or in any way incident or appertaining To have &
to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said William Youngblood his heirs and assigns
forever And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Ex-
ecutors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said Wm
Youngblood his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs
or any other person whomsoever who shall or may from by or
under me lawfully claim the same or any part thereof
