Harties corner. Then with his line N 11 E. 94 pole to a pine then N 16 W. 14 pole to a B. O. Thump P. Harkes corner then N 24 E. 22 pole to a small B. O. bush then N 11 E. E. 40 pole to a Spanish Oak then S 03 W. 92 pole to a small B. O. then S 15 E. 101 pole to a B. O. Look line and then with his line S 45 W. 136 poles to the beginning containing 140. acres - more or less with the improvements water, profits hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wife appertaining. and the remainder & reversion rents issues and profits to the same belonging.
