

1064 Benjamin Blake Two hundred and fifteen acres of ¹⁴¹ land in Edgecombe County on the north side of Rocky Swamp beginning at a red Oak William Jones's corner then N. 80 pole to a red Oak in Samuel Smith's line then along his line W. 228 pole to his corner, course continued 147 pole to a red Oak then S. 120 poles to a Persimmon then E. 120 pole to a pine William Jones's line then along his line N. 40 pole to a red Oak his corner then along his line East to the first Station Dated 25th day of March 1749 —

1065 Thomas Bryant Five hundred and twenty acres of land in Edgecombe County beginning at his own corner white Oak in a Branch on the south side Fishing Creek then N. 9 W. 242 pole to Thomas Foxhalls corner pine then W. 103 pole to Foxhalls other corner pine then along Foxhalls head line N. 33 East 220 pole to Hudnells corner pine then N. 36 East 160 pole along Hudnells line to Fishing Creek then up Fishing Creek the various courses 58 pole to a white Oak by the creek then S. 30 W. 200 pole along Taylors line to a white Oak and pine then W. 114 pole to a pine then S. 160 pole to a white Oak then W. 68 pole to an Oak then South 128 pole to a black Oak ^{then} S. 11. 15 East 234 pole to Harts corner sweet gum then along Harts line to the first Station Dated 26th day of October 1754.

1066 Elisha Battle Six hundred and ninety acres of land in Edgecombe County beginning at Daniel Rops corner then by his line South 240 pole to a Gum then East 460 pole to a pine then W. 240 pole to Gags line then by his line to the first Station Dated 14th day of August 1762 —

1067 John Baker One hundred and Eighty acres of land in Edgecombe County on the north side of Marshy Branch beginning at a Poplar then E. one hundred and twenty pole to a pine then North two hundred pole to a pine then West twenty two pole to a live Oak on the said Branch then the various courses of said Branch to the first Station Dated 25th day of March 1752 —
