

At The Request of William & Jane the following Deed was Recorded November 10th 1761

This Indenture made the Twentieth day of October on the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty one Between William Thomas of Frederick County in the Province of Maryland of the one part And William Doran of Prince Georges County in said Province of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Thomas for and in Consideration of the sum of eighty five pounds Current Money to him then and paid before the signing and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge hath Bargained Sold Alien Conferred and made Over And by these presents Doth bargain Sell Alien Conferred and made Over unto the said William Doran his heirs and assigns for ever all that part or Tract of Land called the Mistake Lying in Prince Georges County Beginning at a White Oak Plant growing

beginning Tree of Silver Delight and the beginning of another Delight in form as yet kept by the said William Doran and his heirs and assigns with all And singular the premises and Appurtenances to the said Land and Tract of Land and the said William Doran his heirs and assigns for ever and the said William Thomas for himself his heirs and assigns Covenant and Agrees to and with the said William Doran his heirs and assigns that he the said William Thomas and his heirs shall and will defend and forever defend by these presents and Lawfully the said William Thomas for himself and his heirs Doth Covenant and Agrees to and with the said William Doran his heirs and assigns that he the said William Thomas and his heirs shall and will at any time hereafter at the Request of and at the perfect cost and charge in the Law of the said William Doran his heirs or assigns make any fine Dead or Waiting for the Debt securing and the said William Doran his heirs or assigns unto him the said William Doran his heirs and assigns In Testimony whereof the said William Thomas hath hereunto set his hand and Affixed his Seal The Day and year first above written

October the 20th 1761 Then came William Thomas Senr. before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of the Provincial Court of Maryland and Acknowledged all his Right Title and Interest of and to the said Land of Premises to William Doran his heirs and assigns and at the same time came Elizabeth the wife of the said William Thomas who being privately Examined out of the hearing of her said Husband and Inquired all his Right Title of and to the aforesaid Land of Premises to the said William Doran his heirs and assigns that she was therein by fear or Threats of or Ill usage from her said Husband
