The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above Bounden John Black his heirs heirs Adminors or any of them Do or shall upon Reasonable Request to him or them be made by the above Named William Black his heirs or Assigns at a County Court or Court of Common Pleas to be held at Lewes for the County of Sussex afo: shall then Convey and Assure unto the said William Black and his heirs and Assigns forever a certain Parcel of Land situated in the County of Sussex afo: in Broadkill Hundred it being Part of Larger Parcel of Land formerly belonging to Samuel Black Dec: is formerly sold the Black Swamp and the with such Assurance as the said William Black or his Council learned in the Law shall be Reasonably or Devised According to Law or Due to the Lord or Lords of the fee or fees For or in Respect of Premises Only except and afore said then the above Obligation to be Voyed and of No Effect Else to stand and Remain in full force and Virtue
