rally firmly by these presents sealed with our
Seals & dated this 15th day of February A.D. 1790.

The Condition of the Above Obligation is such
that whereas the Above bound George Wimberley hath
this day obtained a License for a marriage intended
to be had & solemnized between him & Phoebe Henton
of Said County, Now if Case it shall not hereafter appe-
ar that there is any lawful Cause to obstruct
Said Marriage then the Above Obligation to be void else
to remain in full force & Virtue.
