By means of which said premises your petitioners represent and claim, that the said Peter Everitt, Esther Lansing, Polly Sturges, Moses Soner, Ahraham Soner, Peter Soner, and David Soner are each seized in fee simple of one equal undivided ninth part of the lands and tenements above described, with the appurtenances, the whole into nine equal parts to be divided; that the said Stephen Cleveland is seized in fee simple of one other equal undivided minth part thereof, and also of one equal undivided fourth of one other undivided ninth part thereof, the whole into nine equal parts to be divided; or of five equal undivided thirty-sixth parts thereof, the whole into thirty-six equal parts to be divi-ded. And that the said James Palmatier, Catharine Wilson, and Sally Ann Van Wyck, are each seized in fee simple of one equal undivided fourth of one undivided ninth part thereof, the whole into nine equal parts to be divided; or each ofone equal undivided thirty-sixth part thereof, the whole into thirty-six, equal parts to be divided, subject to the dower of the said Jane Soner. widow of Cornelius Soper, deceased, therein, as above set forth.
