KNOW ALL MEN by these Presents, That we, Jane Rutherford
Margaret Campbell & James Mogg
are held and firmly bound unto Alext Martin
in the just and full Sum of two Thousand Pounds Specie
Pounds, current Money of said State, to be paid to the said Alext Martin
or his Successors in Office: To the which Payment, well and truly to be made, we
bind ourselves, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly and severally,
firmly by these Presents, sealed with our Seals, and dated this 30th
Day of January Anno Domini, 1782

THE CONDITION of this Obligation is such, That
if the above bound Jane Rutherford

Administratrix of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits, of
Thomas Rutherford deceased, do make, or cause
to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods and Chattels,
Rights and Credits of the Deceased, which have, or shall come to the Hands, Know-
ledge, or Possession of the laid Jane Rutherford

or into the Hands or Possession of any other
Person or Persons, for her and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhi-
bited, into the Secretary's Office, and one attested Copy thereof to the County Court,
where Orders for Administration passed, within Ninety Days after the Date of these
Presents; and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits, and all other the Goods, Chat-
tels and Credits of the Deceased, at the Time of his Death, which at any Time
hereafter shall come into the Hands or Possession of the said Jane Rutherford

or into the Hands or Possession
of any other Person or Persons for her do well and truly administer, according to
Law; and further, do make, or cause to be made, a true and just Account of
said Administration, within One Year after the Date of these Presents; and all the Rest
and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels and Credits, which shall be found remaining
upon the said Administratrix Account, (the same being first examined and allowed
by the Governor and Council, General Court or County Court) shall deliver and pay
unto such Person or Persons respectively, as the same shall be due, pursuant to the true
Intent and Meaning of the Act in that Case made and provided: And if it shall appear,
that any Will and Testament was made by the said Deceased, and the Executor or
Executors therein named do exhibit the same into Court, making Request to have it
allowed and approved accordingly, if the said Jane Rutherford

above bounden, being thereunto required,
do render and deliver the said Letters of Administration, (Approval of such Testa-
ment being first heard and made in the said Court:) Then this Obligation to be void,
and of none Effect; or else to remain in full Force and Virtue.
