GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of God, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. To the Sheriff of the County of Northampton Greeting. We command you that you take the Bodies of Lydia Bryan Benjamin Bryan, and William Bustin, Executors of the last will and last will of Charles Bryan deceased, late of your county,

(if to be found in your Bailiwick) and them safely keep, so that you have them before our Chief Justice, and his Associates, at the next Superior Court of Justice, to be held for the District of Edenton at the Court-House in Edenton on the twenty fifth Day of October next; then and there to Abraham Maco for Breach of Covenant, &c, to the Damage of the said Abraham, the sum of five hundred pounds proclamation money

Herein fail not; and have you there this Writ. Witness *Markus Howard* Esq; Chief Justice of our said Province, at Edenton the twenty fifth Day of April in the ninth Year of our Reign, Anno Dom. 1769
