Jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals, and dated the 4th
day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight and in
the thirty second year of American Independence

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above bounden Isabella
Barnhill & Rob^t Hemphill Administrators of the goods, Chattles, and Credits of Wm Barnhill
deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all & singular
