be a part of the land last mentioned reserving to my widow her third
part of all my lands during her natural life 2^{ndly} My will
& desire is that all my sons as soon as they are old enough shall be
bound out as apprentices to some good mechanical trade and mas-
ters appointed at the discretion of my Executors herein after named
3^{rdly} That all the remainder & residue of my estate be equally divi-
ded between my children before mentioned reserving to my wife her
especial

192 1st my will & desire is that my executors at the reasonable re-
quest of the administrator of Jacob Mason dec^d shall appear & make
a Deed to the heirs of the said Jacob Mason for 30 acres of land & rip-
ple now lying in their pond & below it, the said Jacob Mason adm^r
first paying the caution money & other charges accruing in making
a title for the same.

5th & lastly I nominate, constitute & appoint my wife & my bro-
ther Benjamin to be my whole & sole executors of this my last will
& testament, & to carry the foregoing premises fully into effect, as wit-
ness my hand & seal this seventeenth day of December in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety seven.
