 Breath from my Earthly Tabernacle I Commit unto God my Creator
 and my Body unto the Earth with desire it may be Buried in a
 Christian Like manner and as Touching my worldly Goods God in
 his mercy hath bestowed on me I give and bestow in manner and
 form following vizt First my will and Desire is that all my Just
 Debts should be duly Paid.

Item I Give and Demise unto my loving wife Sophia my Dwellinghouse
 and Plantation with all the Land thereunto belonging During her natural
 Life and after her decease to Devise unto my two Daughters Sorana & Ruth
 and their Lawful Heirs forever.

Item My will and Desire is that in Consideration that I have given the
 Profit of my Land unto my wife During her life that she shall Raise
 maintain and School my two Daughters Sorana & Ruth on her Own
 Expence & that to be done in a decent like Christian manner.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sorana One Gold Ring &
 one Cow and calf to be delivered or Paid to her at the Age of fifteen years
 the Ring fifteen Shillings.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Ruth One Cow & calf & One Gold
 Ring of fifteen Shillings Price to be delivered to her at the Age of fifteen years

Item All the Rest of my Estate not disposed of as mentioned above after my
 debts are Paid I give and bequeath unto my wife Sophia.

Item And I do ordain constitute and Appoint my wife Sophia Executrix
 and my father in Law William Poynter Executors Joyntly of this my
 Last will and Testament And I do hereby Pronounce Acknowledge

and Declare the above to be my last will & that
 day of February 1800 in the presence of
 before my hand and official seal as follows

 sake could not take the oath I did on his solemn affirmation declare
 affirm that in his sight present and hearing the Testator named
 Hudson design such Publick Document and Declare the above
 written to be his last will and Testament and that at the doing thereof
 the said Testator was of sound and perfect disposing mind memory
 and Judgment and that he together with William Poyner and
 William Haldon Subscribed the same as witnesses at request
 in presence of the Testator.

 Body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the
 Direction of any executor nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
 raise the same again by the mighty Power of God and as Touching such and
 Estate wherewith I shall please God to bless me in this life I give and devise
