

In the name of God Amen the 21st of March in the year of our Lord 1770 I Magdaline Manlove of Sussex County on Delaware being in health and of Perfect mind and memory Thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all One to die I do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried at the Discretion of my Executors and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath Pleased God to bestow me in this life I give devise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and Form

I Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jonathan One Negro man Called dig and a Negro Girl Called Casy

I Item I give to my son Boaz all my right and Title of the Tract of Land where I now Live to him and to his Heirs forever and Likewise One Negro man called Dover and Likewise a Negro woman Called Susanna and a Bed and furniture

I Item I give to my son Manuel One Tract of Land Called mount pleasant Containing Three Hundred and forty Acres to him and to his heirs forever and Likewise a negro Boy Called Robin

I Item I give to my Grand Daughter Unice Waller One negro Girl Called Hager and my fine Rachel

I Item I give to my son James Owens the half of a Tract of Land Called the Turkey Swamp to him and to his Heirs forever

I Item I Leave the other half of the Tract of Land Called the Turkey Swamp with all the rest of my moveable Estate in the hands of my Three Sons Viz Jonathan Boaz and Manuel for to Pay my daughter Elizabeth twenty

Bounds Out of my Estate and and my wearing Cloaths
 I give to my Daughter Ann Barnoughs twenty five Bounds of my
 I give to my Grand Daughter Mary Manlove twenty Bounds to be p
 her at the Age of Eighteen years Old
 I give to my Grand Daughter Betty Manlove twenty Bounds to be
 paid her at the Age of Eighteen years Old the Daughters of George Manlove
 I Do hereby utterly Disallow all and every other former Testaments wills
 by me in any ways before this Time made willed and bequeathed and
 ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and
 Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal

 mind memory and Judgment and that they and each of them together
 with Charles Polke Sen. subscribed the same as evidences at request and
 in Presence of the Testatrix
