sed in body but in perfect mind & memory, Thank be to God
therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing

of Ottally with all the Improvements Benefits and Privileges
thereunto belonging after the Death of my wife Margaret
Newbold, likewise four hundred Acres of Land which came
by Wife Margaret Newbold.

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Wife Margaret
Newbold all the Rest and Residue of Estate to be at her
disposal.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Mar-
garet Newbold and William Newbold to be my whole and sole
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby
disallow, Revoke and disannull all and every other Will and
Testament. In Testimony whereof I the Testator have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty eight day of April
One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Seven
