Almighty God depose and saith that in their sight present  
hearing the Testator Joseph Miller did sign Seal publish pronounce  
and deliver the within Written to be his Last Will and Testament  
and the above Codicils to be added to and be a part thereof and that  
at the doing thereof the said Testator was of sound and perfect  
disposing mind memory and judgment to the best of their  
knowledge and belief; and that they and each of them together  
with John Mose and Joseph Freeman Subscribed the same as  
Witnesses at request and in presence of the Testator  
Phillips Hollock Reg.

In the Name of God Amen I Solomon Hill being in a  
Weak and low Condition and calling to mind the Mortality of my  
state and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die  
do constitute Ordain and appoint this as my Last Will and  
Testament and as for what Estate it has pleased God to  
bestow upon me in this life I give and bequeath it in the  
manner and form as followeth being in perfect Senses  
that is to say

I give unto my well beloved wife Betty Hill all my whole and  
Sole Estate both real and Personal during her life allowing her  
the whole and Sole Executrix

After the decease of my wife Betty Hill I will my Estate to be  
equally divided between my two Daughters viz Comfort  
Hill and Sammey Brien in a quiet and peaceable manner  
Thirdly and lastly I constitute and Ordain this to be my Last Will  
and Testament annulling all others heretofore by me made

as Witness my hand this eighth day of January in the year of our  
 Lord One thousand seven hundred and Seventy eight  
 Signed sealed and Delivered  
 in presence of us
