 are of this our last will and Testament
 and do hereby in their several names and dis-
 avow all and every other former Testaments
 wills - wishes and bequests by me made
 named wishes - wishes and bequests by me
 and my wife to be in full and satisfaction
 on the terms whereof I have herewith set my
 hand and seal the day and year above written -

 his last will and Testament in the presence of us
 the subscribers -

 their right presence and hearing the testator
 John Dillworth did sign seal publish pronounce
 and declare the within written to be his last
 will and Testament and that at the doing
 thereof the said testator was of sound and
 perfect disposing mind memory and judgment -
 Test given & attested E. R. C.

On the Town of New York the second day
 of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1845
 I Thomas Goldsmith in the County of Sussex
 a woman being sick and weak in body but of
 perfect mind and memory praised the Lord
 therefore calling to mind and knowing the mortality
 of our bodies and knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die to make herein this
 my last will and Testament that is to say princip-
 ally and first of all I give and recommend my
 soul to God that gave it and my body &

recommends it to the Court to be sworn at the dis-
 cretion of my executor and their doubtless but at
 the General Court I shall receive the same
 by the authority of God and as I am now and
 forever do hereby with full power to do so
 I shall in this my will and testament
 the same in the following manner and form -
 I do give and bequeath to my right beloved
 son Thomas Goldsmith that tract of land
 called Fox with the house and other buildings
 as called for with the acreage belonging to the same
 as now owned by son Thomas Goldsmith the
 plantation that I now use upon the same and
 being on either side each a service the small and
 lying on the west side of Upper River only the
 eighth. That the rest of my children shall or may
 have liberty to divide their portions upon the said
 Island of Fox River and that they do no fur-
 ther -

I likewise constitute and appoint my well
 beloved son John as Goldsmith and my son in
 law Joseph Williams my executors and sole executors
 of this my last will and testament -

I likewise constitute, appoint and ordain all
 the rest of my movable estate to be equally divided
 between all my children with that tract of land
 on the west side of Upper River to be equally di-
 vided both in quantity and quality -

I likewise give and bequeath to my youngest
 daughter Ann Goldsmith three pounds to be
 carried out of my estate to school her withal and
 if the family should have a desire that her God-
 father may have her and take care of her until she
 shall arrive to the age of sixteen I desire that
 after my first debt is paid and fully satisfied
 that she be paid that my son John Goldsmith
 Patience Williams may have her portion as soon as
 the law requires that is to say on a twelve month
 and a day and the rest of my daughters that is
 to say Comfort Goldsmith Mary Goldsmith Susan
 Goldsmith and Hannah Goldsmith shall have
 their respective portions at the day of marriage -
 until they shall arrive to the age of twenty years -

I do give and bequeath all the rest and
 now for the use of the family and all need to be
 provided by the said persons satisfied and allowing
 this and no other to be my last will and testament
 in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal
 the day and year above written (Note the words above
 was read out before the solemnizing of these presents) -
