Memorandum that I then came
The above mentioned Credences
before me in their proper persons and
I did call upon the Holy Evangelist
that the above mentioned will was the last will
and Testament of Christian Barnumson and Ack-
nowledged by him to be his last and true as he
was my hand the day and year above written
I am the Credence.

In the Name of God Amen This Twentieth day
of January in the thousand and seven hundred
and eight Thomas Barnumson of Sussex County
Barren to my knowledge and against my body but by
sound mind and perfect memory joined in the right
God I do make and ordain this my last
will and Testament in manner and form as fol-
loweth that is to say I do and principally I desire
my body and the Burial of my body to be committed
to the earth from whence it was
taken. This to be done at the discretion
of my survivors. And as for my worldly goods
whereof the word of his goodness and mercies
brought me a love and desire as to the same -
I give and bequeath unto the Child
my wife now goes with it in my plantation that
I now live on with the land. Thereunto belonging and
it is not a son I give the said land and plantation
to my daughter Sarah from and my wife's decease
I give unto my wife one half of my personal
estate after my death I give the right hand
I give the other half to my daughter Sarah and the
Child my wife now goes with it to be equally divided
between them and to constitute and appoint my
sons Thomas Barnumson whole and sole executor of this
my last will and Testament and the Revoking all
other and former wills by me made, I do publish and
declare this to be my last and Testament whereof I have
herewith set my hand and seal the day and year first
above written
