The Last Will and Testament of John Husbands of Cecil County as Follows by the following witnesses being duly and solemnly sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God James Parr and Mary Parr declares that a few hours before the said John Husbands died he desired they should take notice that his will was that all his Personal Estate should be equally divided between his sister in Law Elizabeth Parr and Ephraim Mutchings truly begotten in wedlock by his Sister Sarah Mutchings wife to Joshua Mutchings likewise that his real Estate should be equally divided between the said Elizabeth Parr and Ephraim Mutchings during the Life of the said Elizabeth and after her decease that the said Ephraim Mutchings should enjoy all his Lands and appurtenances thereto belonging and that he therefore constituted and appointed his Sister in Law Elizabeth Parr and Joshua Mutchings his Executors and these Defendants further declare that the said John Husbands at the time of his so doing he was to the best of their apprehension of sound and disposing mind and memory and that he Died about two of the clock on Thursday the 17th Instant June A.D. 1747 Anno Domini 1747/8.
