William Hayden my tract of Land I now live on Called & known
by the name of Small hoped to him & the heirs of his body for ever
and for want & Default of such heirs I Give & bequeath it to my

Loving Daughter Mary Redder & her heires for ever I Give &
 bequeath to my Loving Daughter Mary Redder my best & my
 Coates linnen & Woollen to her & her heires for ever
 I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Penelope Allman twelve
 pence All the remaining part of my personal Estate I Give
 and bequeath to my Loving Son William Hayden & my loving
 Daughter Mary Redder to them & their heires for ever to be equally
 Divided between them. Lastly I do make Ordaine and
 Constitute my Loving Son William Hayden my whole and
 Sole Executor of this my last will and testament In Witness
