Item, I give and bequeath to my three sons, Iakob Hudson, Lewin Hudson, and Seth Hudson, all my Land that is my right and property lying and being in the County of York, to wit, my land called the ^{Great Lyngens} and joining to John Marshall's Land, and all my Land that is my right and property lying and joining any of the aforesaid Indian Land to be my right and property of my three sons, to them and their heirs lawfully begotten of their bodies forever, but none of any single one of them without an issue, then my survivors shall enjoy, as whole them and their heirs forever.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son, Iakob Hudson, two hundred acres of land part of a tract of land called Edwards's to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever and my little touch near Spinn.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son, Iakob Hudson, my Long Gun to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son, Lewin Hudson, my other Gun called a Indian to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body forever.

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter, Hannah, Hudson one Vest called a Red Vest and two cows and calves to her and her heirs lawfully begotten forever.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son, Iakob Hudson, one bush and one Shilling, Sterling Money of Great Britain to him and his heirs lawfully begotten forever.

And my Remains of my estate to be equally divided among my children here named, to wit, Iakob Hudson, Dennis Hudson, Lewin Hudson, Seth Hudson, and Hannah Hudson, to them and their heirs forever, and I do constitute and Ordain my Loving Wife Sarah Hudson, and my son Iakob Hudson, Executors of this my last Will and Testament, In Witness Whereof, I have here set my hand, and also fixt my Seal, this 26th Day of August, 1760.

and bequeath my Negro called Cesar to my Son Samuel My Will I Give and bequeath

unto my Daughter Sally one feather bed and furniture One Chest of Drawers
one Man and a Saddle, one Boy, one Butler plate two Dishes and two Knapes.
I Give unto my Son Robert one desk and one Case of Bottles, One young Horse
called Light foot Knicker and a Saddle and all my stock to be equally divided
between my two Sons Robert and Samuel And for y^e Remainder ^{part} of my estate
be it what it kinde soever My Will is that it may be equally Divided between my
