 Fogator being at present weak sick and in low Condition as to my
 bodily health but of sound and perfect Memory for which I praise
 the Lord and taking into my serious Consideration the frailty and
 Mortality of my Nature and the uncertainty of my life here -
 upon Earth Do make this my last will hereby revoking and
 annulling all former wills and Testam^t by me made Do constitute
 this to be my last will and Testament -

In the first place I bequeath my soul to God my blessed and
 Merciful Creator beging from and looking to him for the
 Salvation of the same by the Merits and Mediation of Jesus
 Christ my blessed Redeemer - And my body to the Earth from
 whence it was taken by faith Expecting the Resurrection of
 the Same and as to what worldly Estate or goods the Lord has -

Been pleased to bestow upon my will Concerning the same is as followeth
I leave and Bequeath to my eldest son Jeremiah Dinter the Housing Orchard
and other Conventiences belonging to the plantation where I now live
to be understood of my real and personall Estate, with two hundred Acres of
Land Convenient or adjoining to the same to be Enjoyed and possessed by
him and his heirs for ever

I Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Dinter two hundred Acres of Land
adjoining to these two hundred Acres Bequeathed to my son Jeremiah as before
and running up towards the Old plantation I Bequeath the same to her and to her
heirs for ever The two hundred Acres to be laid out upon the Eastward
side of the plantation where I now live and joining upon the line of
Jeremiah Townsend

I Bequeath to my son John Dinter and to his heirs for ever two hundred
Acres of Land adjoining to the lands already Bequeathed to my son Jeremiah
and Daughter Mary the same to include the Orchard belonging to the
Old plantation

I Bequeath to my son Nehemiah one hundred Acres of Land adjoining &
Binding up in the two hundred Acres Bequeathed to John the same one hundred
Acres of Land my will is that it return to John Dinter my son and his heirs
for ever after the Death of my son Nehemiah

To my Beloved wife Helenor I leave and bequeath the possession
improvements and benefit of the plantation where I now live until
such time as my son Jeremiah comes to the age of Twenty one years

My will is that my personall Estate be Divided in three Equall parts my
wife to Enjoy one third part and the other two to be Divided Equally or in
Equall portions to my four Children already mentioned

As by this my last will and Testament Appereth and Constitute my
Beloved wife Helenor to be the Ex^r of the same Requesting that my Loving
friend Abraham Smith may Take Care to oversee the Execution of this my
will, and be as Instant to my Ex^r in Confirmation of all which I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty Seventh day of Jan^y
Anno Dom 1722
