In the name of God Amen I Jasper Turner
of the County of Anson and State of North
Carolina being in Sound Mind and Memory
do make this to be my last will and testament
In the first place I want all my Just debt paid
and those due me collected.

First I give and bequeath unto my wife Lucy
Turner my plantation and Tract of Land whereon
I now live containing three hundred ^{and fifteen} Acres more or
less also I give and bequeath unto my wife Lucy
a Negro man by the name of Tom her life time
and then to my three Daughters to wit) Diley
Elizabeth and Polly Turner also I want at the
death of my wife Lucy Turner the Said Tract
of Land that I have willed to her to be equally
divided among all my Legates. also I give to
my wife all my Stock of every description two
if she and the family thinks proper to keep part
of them they can do so. also my wagon and
cart and plantation tools to my Said wife Lucy.
also I wish at her death I want some of my
neighbors to value these things last named and
make a division of them among my children
without a fee. But if the Said Lucy Turner
survives I want for her to have a equal part
with my children and no more

Now the Stock that I have mentioned to about to be
Sold the money arising from that Sale I want
it to be put to the use of educating my Son Martin
Turner but if there should be more money from the
Sale of Stock than is necessary to Educate my Son
Martin I want the rest to be equally divided among the
rest of my children

Also I give and bequeath unto my Son Green Turner
a certain Tract of Land adjoining Left Hand Wood and
and William Kitchen containing 200 acres more or
less. In the next place I give unto my Son Arthur
Turner a certain Tract of Land that I purchased of
John and William Sagg adjoining Frederick Staton
and John Allen containing 200 acres more or less
lying on the water of Crick Creek
also I give unto my Son Martin Turner a certain
parcel or Tracts of Land lying on the waters
of Arnets Branch ~~and~~ containing 199 acres
also another Tract of Land bought of Joseph Medley
going by the name of the Harrison Place containing
100 acres more or less. also a place entry that I have
made adjoining John Allen Frederick Staton and my
Self which I wish to be paid with money out of
my estate and for the Land to belong to my Son
Martin containing 8 acres. as for my house hold
and Kitchen furniture I want for it to stay as it is
but if one or more of the family wishes or needs part
of the furniture for the family to give off what they
think is their equal part

and I hereby make George Turner and Arthur
Turner to be my Executors to this my last will and
Testament, June 13th 1828
