Carr One feather bed and furniture to her her Heirs
and assigns for Ever

I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Martha
Ford One feather bed and furniture to her her
Heirs and assigns for Ever

And it is my will and Desire after my Just debts
are paid that all the Residue of my Estate be
Equally Divided between my severall Children
here after named Joseph Turner John Turner Mary
Gardner Patience Carr Ann Hinton Martha
Ford Elisabeth Turner Sannet Thompson to be
Dev'd by my Executors here after named, I do
here by make and Ordain my Grandson Balys
House and Thomas Bond Junr. Executors of this
my last will and Testament in witness whereof
I the said Mathew Turner have set my hand and
seal the day and Year Above written Signed sealed
Delivered and pronounced by the said Mathew
Turner the Testator as his last will and Testament
