

50 Record of Wills February Court 1846

State of North Carolina A. D. 1845
Chelavland County ^{March} February 17th
I Bluford Randal of the county
of Chelavland and State of North Carolina
Being of Sound Mind and Memory but
considering the uncertainty of my earthly
existence do make and declare this my
last Will and Testament in Manner &
form following that is to say, I give &
devise to my beloved wife Maria all my
land, and House, and improvements
to Have and to Hold to her the said wife
for and during the term of her natural
life in Satisfaction and then she is to
dispose of it as she please; for and
in lieu of her Dowry and thirds of and
in all my real Estate; And if there
is any property left, I want it sold
and equally divided amongst all my
Children

And lastly I do hereby consti-
tute and appoint my Trusty friends
James Boggs and Solomon Willis my
lawfull Executors to all intents and pur-
poses to execute this my last Will and Tes-
tament according to the true intent &
meaning of the same, and every part
and clause thereof; hereby revoking and
declaring thereby void all other Wills and
Testaments by me heretofore made

Record of Wills May court 1846

In the Name of God Amen

J. Samuel Pattimore of the County of Cleaveland and State of North Carolina, being sick in body but of perfect Mind and Memory, and knowing the uncertainty of life, and the certainty of Death. Do make this my last Will and Testament, as follows - this 26th day of April A.D. 1846 -

First I desire that my body be interred in a decent burial - And my soul committed to God who gave it

Secondly I will and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Lucinda; the following property (to wit) Two Negro Men - Abner & Peter - and Negro Woman Anna - (Abners wife) and her increase - Also the tract of land on which I live containing about 310 Acres, more or less with all its improvements - during her natural life - and after her death to be equally divided among all my Children

Also two Mules - One Claybank colt and a small Horse with a blaze face six cows & calves her choice, 3 choice Cattle for Beef - All the Old Wheat on hand and the growing crop - All the Sheep and Hogs also the corn that is on hand and the growing crop - all the Stock of Provisions that is on hand - all the Household and Kitchen furniture - Carriage & Harness

Thirdly, I desire that all the Balance of my Notes, Cash & property be sold by my Executors and the Money put to Interest until the Children comes of age or Marry, and then each Child to receive an equal dividend, and each Child to be educated by the Interest of their Estate provided their Mother should not feel able to do so
