And bequeath to my daughter Mary McNeill a girl
named Bet. I give and bequeath to my daughter
Floryan McNeill another girl named Martha and also
to my daughter Margaret Jane McNeill a negro girl named
Olivia and to my daughter Barbara McNeill a negro
girl named Mary and I do also will and bequeath to
My dear beloved wife Elizabeth McNeill and two sons
James McNeill and Archibald McNeill and I am p^{er}pet
to beorn nine hundred and seventy eight acres of land
being and lying in the County of Cumberland Conclude
the house and plantation I live now on and a gristmill
Also three hundred acres in the county of Robeson
lying on the South west side of great rock fish
And also I bequeath to my wife and fore said sons
And in part a negroman named Jack a negro girl
Woman named Hannah and one named Perry and a
girl named ~~Cate~~ ^{Cate} and also two boys one named
Frank and one named Arual my Stock of horses
Cattle Sheep and hogs to the Coman use of the
family my house hold furniture I leave to the
Discretion of my wife Elizabeth McNeill to use
As she thinks proper I Also ordain and request
that my daughters all have there living of the
the said plantation until ~~such~~ they marry

I also ordain and request that all lawful debts
shall be paid out of the estate and all debts
to be collected I nominate and appoint My wife con-
sulting W. C. McMill and Duncan McMill Junior
Executors to this my last will and testament re-
voking all other and former wills by me at any
time here to fore made in witness where of I have
hereunto Set my hand and Seal this the 28th of octo-
ber in the year of our Lord 1828
