In the Name of God Amen. I Joseph Lane of the County and Parish of Edgecomb in the Province of North Carolina being thro' the abundant Mercy and Goodness of God, tho' weak in Body, yet of a sound and perfect Understanding and Memory, do constitute this my last Will and Testament, and desire it may be receiv'd by all as such: (Imprimis,) I most humbly bequeath my soul to God, my Maker, beseeching his most gracious Acceptance of it, through the all Sufficient Merits and Mediation of my most compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ, who gave himself to be an Attone-  
ment for my Sins, and is able to save, to. utmost all that unto God by him, Seeing he ever liveth to make Intercession for him, and who I trust will not reject me, a returning penitent sinner, when I come to him for Mercy;   
~~in this hope and confidence I comfort my soul with comfort, humbly~~  
beseeching the most blessed and glorious Trinity, the God most holy, most mercifull and gracious, to prepare me for the time of my Desolation, and then to take me to himself into that peace and rest, and incomparable Felicity, which he has prepared for all and fear his holy commandments, blessed be God. Imprimis, I give my Body to the Earth, from whence it was taken, in full assurance of its Resurrection from thence at the last Day; also for my Buriall, I desire it may be decent, without pomp or state, at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named, who I doubt not will manage it with all requisite Prudence. As to my worldly Estate, I will and positively order, that all my Debts be first paid.

Item I give my Brother William Lane the plantation whereon I do now live and all the Land adjoining there to I say to him his Heirs and Affigines for ever, and also the Land whereon William Grifnum now lives, I give to the said William Lane his Heirs and Affigines for ever, I also give and bequeath to William Lane Eighteen Head of Cattle on the Manner Plantation, also all my Pigs and Pigs on the Manner Plantation, and also all my Household Furniture Except such as shall be hereafter mentioned, and also I give to my Brother William Lane the Five following Negroes that is say, Tom, Cate, King, Annaca, Mingo, I say given to him his Heirs and Affigines for ever.

Item I give my Negroe Boy Ploughman to my Brother Hewitt Lane to him his Heirs and Affigines for ever, and also I lend the labour of my Negroes Jack and Cleony to my Father During his natural life and his Desire to return to my Brother William Lane and his Heirs Affigines for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to Winefred Pope my Negroe Girl Title on Condition that the said Winefred Pope Deliver up a bond of Surety bound that then the S. Wench Shall belong to the S. Winefred Pope her Heirs Affigines for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Sister Faith Bynum my Negroe Woman Daffiny to her and her Heirs for ever and my Desire is that all my Hogs and Cattle besides what has been before mentioned to be sold to pay my Debts, further more my will and Desire is that my Negroe Woman Daffrica can be saved without being sold to pay Debts that than my will and Desire is that my Sister Drewsiller Bryant Shall have the said Wench, her and her Heirs Affigines for ever, Item I give and bequeath to my loving knownen Mary Mc Kinney the Bed & Furniture whereon I now lie in her and her Heirs and Affigines for ever.

I do hereby make null and Void all other Wills by me before  
made I do ordain this my last Will and Testament  
I do also appoint John Bradford and Henry Pope sole and sole  
Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness where  
of I have hereunto set my hand seal this 6<sup>th</sup> day of December  
1757
