County and State of North Carolina being very sick and
weak but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to god
and calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing
that it is appointed for all men one to die do make and
ordain this to be my last will and testament
and where as some of my children has received part
of these Leges I desire that there should be and
a count taken of what they have received to wit
Randolph moon one hundred ~~and fifty~~ ^{one} ~~acres~~ ^{acres} of land
and one feather bead and John Buck one cow and
calf and ten ewes and lambs and one feather bead
and Polly Stanfell one feather bead and one cow
and lamb I desire all so that my lands in Wake County
be left with my Executors to be sold to pay my debts
and after my debts is paid all the rest of my property
to be left to my beloved wife during her life ~~the~~
of my property consisting of negroes and stock of every
kind to be equally divided amongst all my children
male and female where unto I appoint to be my
Executors John Stanfell Jun and Jonathan Stanfell
and Nathan Stanfell as witnesses my hand this
14th day of February 1795 John Stanfell
