Twenty six I Mariah Oldrage living in Lincoln county  
North Carolina and in the house of James Garret being in  
in a weak & declining state of body but perfect mind memory  
& judgment thanks to almighty god & calling to mind the  
Mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men  
once to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament in  
manner & form following that is to say after commanding my  
soul to god who gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian  
& decent manner as touching my worldly property I do it set by  
bestowal of in the following manner & bearing first I alone all  
belathing to my grand daughter Hannah Bennet except  
too handsome trinkets that I leave to my two grand daughters  
John Bennet's two eldest daughters Jane I will & bequeath unto  
my grand daughter Hannah Bennet my wheel & cords &c  
My father's bed & half of the bed furniture the balance  
to be given ~~to~~ <sup>in</sup> Bennet's <sup>or now & eternally remaining</sup> will that my funeral expenses  
be first paid ~~it~~ <sup>in</sup> will that my son William Bennet  
shall have my chair of ~~the~~ land that Samuel nicely now  
lives on and for quiet and full execution of this my last  
will and testament I do nominate & appoint James Garret

In the Name of God Amen this 6th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six I Hannah Oldrage living in Lincoln County North Carolina and in the house of James Carrols being in a weak & declining state of body but perfect mind & memory & judgment thanks to Almighty God & calling to mind the Mortality of my Body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form following that is to say after commanding my soul to God who gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian and decent manner & as touching my worldly property I devise to dispose of in the following manner & form first I allow all my clothing to my grand daughter Hannah Bennet Except two homespun frocks that I leave to my two grand daughters John Bennets two oldest daughters Item I will and betroth unto my grand daughter Hannah Bennet the wheel and Cards etc. my feather bed ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ & half of the bed furniture the balance to be John Bennets & pots & kitchen furniture Item I will that my funeral expences Be first paid item I will that my son William Bennet shall have my share of the land that Samuel Neely now lives on and for just and full execution of this my last will & testament I do nominate & appoint James Carroll My Executor signed & Acknowledged day and date above mentioned
