Plantation whereon I now do live containing two
hundred Acre More or Less my Negro fellow
named Sharper my Still Cap & Worm and a Negro
Boy named Scotland to him his Heirs and Assigns
forever Item I give devise and bequeath unto
my Grandson Uriah Baff son of Drury my land
and Plantation whereon the said Drury now
lives containing one hundred Acre more or less
adjoining Dickhomoney Branch on Mofus
Halls line also the half of my land lying in
Urika Swamp joining Col^o Dawson's line
also a Negro Woman named Hannah and
her increase hereafter also a Negro Boy named
Ben to him his Heirs and Assigns forever
Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter
Alice Enys an Negro woman named Pig and

an increment also one Negroe boy named Pompey
Item I leave unto my Daughter Ursula Councill
the use of one Negroe Woman named Dinah and
her increase during her life and at her decease
I give & devise and bequeath the said Negroe woman
Dinah and her increase afterwards to be equally
divided between or amongest her Children
Item I give & devise and bequeath unto my Grand
son Jeph Bittle son of John Bittle the Land
and Plantation whereon the said John Bittle
now lives containing two hundred Acres more
or less bounded on an agreed line already made
also one hundred Acres of land adjoining my
son Jethro's land an agreed line already made
onto Joyming Charles Boyard's line also fifty Acres
of land I purchased of John Kerney according
to the most known and reputed bounds thereof
also one Negroe girl named Jane and her
increase to him his Heirs & Friends forever
Item I give & devise and bequeath unto my Grand
daughter Wennefer Bittle one Negroe boy named
Davy, Item I give unto my Grandson John Bittle
one Negroe girl and her increase named Batt
Item I give unto my Granddaughter Margaret
Bittle one Negroe girl named Rachel and
her increase Item I give & devise and bequeath unto
my Grandson Drury Bittle one Negroe boy
named Isham, Item I give unto my Daughter
Elizabeth Bittle one Negroe woman named

Judeith and her increase hereafter, Item I give devise
and bequeath all the remainder of my Estate that is
not in my Will given a way to be equally divided
