In the Name of God amen. I Nathaniel Jones of Northampton County
being perfectly in my senses do make my last Will as follows.

Imprimis I give to my son George his Choice of my riding Horses, Sock & Lightfoot.

Item. It is my Will that all my perishable Estate (Negroes excepted) including
Furniture, be sold by my Executors, when they shall think proper, on twelve
Months Credit.

Item. I give & devise to my six Children, Robert, George, Allen, Willie, Famerlane &
Elizabeth, an equal proportion of all my Estate, real & personal (the Horse given
to George excepted) Share & Share alike, to them, their Heirs & Assigns:— And it
shall be divided by such persons as my Executors shall make Choice of at
Christmas next ensuing or thereabouts, into six equal Shares, one to each of
my said Children. — And the Share which shall be allotted to my son
Robert, shall be given up to him immediately on the division. — The other
dividends shall be given up to my other Children, as they shall respectively
come of age or marry: — But if any of my said Children die before they
come of age or marry, the Share which belonged
to such Child or Children, to be equally divided between my surviving
Children, share & Share alike.

Lastly. I appoint Willie Jones & my son Robert Executors of this my last
Will, hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made. In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this 16th day of February 1783.
