In the name of God amish I George Musick of  
Rutherford County being of sound and disposing mind  
and memory do make publish and declare this my last  
will and testament hereby revoking all other wills by me  
at any time heretofore made

first I will and direct all my just debts to be speedily paid

Second. I will and devise to my son Jonathan Musick and  
his Heirs for ever all that part of the tract of land bought  
By me of Russell Twitty lying on the North side of Green  
River on which he now lives

Thirdly I will and devise that so my grandson Willm.  
Hawkins there be given when he shall attain the age of  
Twenty one years a Horse of the value of Eighty Dollars  
To be paid for out of the property devos'd by me to my wife  
Lurter Musick

Fourth I give and devise to Mch't Hawkins the sum of  
Five shillings

Fifth I will and devise to my daughter Pheby, and the  
Heirs of her body all the tract of land bought by me of  
Russell Twitty lying on the south side of Green River  
(except fifty acres adjoining Alexander Watson's land)  
And so much of the tract on which I live as will make it  
up in the whole one hundred and fifty acres - this clause  
I make under the express prohibition that the above land  
shall not ~~be~~ by the said Phebe or any other person be sold  
or alienated but shall at her decease remain to the use  
of her children. Sixth all the residue of my prop-  
erty real and personal of what kind soever I give and devise  
To my wife Lurter during her natural life

Seventh I give and devise to my son Austin Musick and  
His heirs forever at the decease of my wife Lurter all  
the tract of land lying on the north side of Green River.  
Bought by me of Matthew Watson

Eighth My will and desire is that at the decease of my  
wife Lurter the residue of my property of every de-  
-ception be equally divided between my sons Austin and  
Jonathan and my daughter Phoebe or their heirs, with  
The exception of two hundred Dollars in money now in my  
hands the disposal of which I give to my wife Lurter at  
her decease. ~~In witness whereof I have hereunto set my~~  
~~Hand and seal this twenty first day of January in the year~~  
And I do hereby constitute and appoint Austin Musick  
and Jonathan Musick Executors of this my last will and  
Testament. In witness whereof I have here unto set my  
Hand and Seal this twenty first day of January in the  
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine.
