I give to my daughter Cynthia Utley my gray mare ~~and~~ and one hunting saddle and bridle and two cows and calves one feather bed and furniturn one pewter dish one bason six plates and four spoons one washing tub and piggy one woolling wheel and one Loom one ewe and Lamb one Sow and piggs six geese

I give to my Son Gabriel Utley my bay horse saddle and bridle one feather bed and furniturn and my still two ~~cows~~ heifers one ewe and Lamb one Sow and piggs and six geese one pewter dish one bason six plates and four spoons one pot and six knives and forks and one smooth boared gun.
