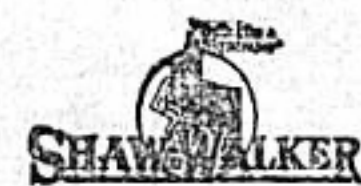

In the name of God Amen I Theophilus  
Pool of the County of Wake in the State of North  
Carolina being of Sound mind and memory  
do make and declare this to be my last will  
and Testament in manner and form as follows  
to wit:

First.

My Will and desire is that all my just-  
debts be paid.

Second. My will is that my wife Clara Pool  
have all my tract of Land whereon I now live  
during her life unless she Marries, in that case  
she is to have a child's part of said Land  
Also one Bed & furniture, one wheel and <sup>and</sup> <sup>children</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>children</sup>  
and one loom and at her death to be divided between my  
Third

I further will and desire that all the balance  
of my property be sold and the money arising  
from the same to be equally divided between  
my wife & children subject to advances to  
made to some of my children they first to account  
for all advances before they shall be entitled  
to share any of the proceeds of said sale.

My further will is and I particularly require  
that my wife Clara Pool shall not in any  
way cut and destroy the timber of the said Land  
mentioned in the second Clause of this will  
more than is sufficient to make her support.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand and affixed my seal this the 16<sup>th</sup> day  
of November 1845. A.D.
