State of North Carolina Wayne County  
Be it remembered this fifteenth day of the  
Twelfth month One thousand Eight Hundred &  
thrice. — That I Arthur Bryan being of sound  
and disposing mind and memory, do make & ordain  
this my last will and Testament in manner and  
form as follows: (scry)

First my will and Desire is that all my just  
Debts be paid in due time after my Death.  
Item, I give to my Loving wife Elizabeth Bryan  
one feather bed and furniture, one cow, and one  
pewter Dish, three spoons & three plates to her  
Disposal.

Item I give to my son William Bryan the  
Land and plantation whereon I now live to him and  
his heirs.

I give to my son Joel Bryan the Land  
eon he now lives. to him & his heirs.

Item I give to my Children. Willis, Robert,  
James & Henry Bryan, Mary Griffin Elizabeth  
Lancaster, Cathrine Rice, & Sarah Lancaster,  
each of them five shillings to them & their heirs.

Item I give all the remaining part of my movable  
Estate to my son William Bryan, to him and  
his heirs.

Lastly I nominate and appoint Isaac Parker  
and William Bryan Executors of this my last  
will and Testament. Revoking & disannulling  
all wills heretofore made by me, Ratifying and  
Confirming this and no other to be my last will  
and Testament.
