I Andrew Bryan of the Township of East Nottingham
in the County of Chester and Province of Pennsylvania farmer
being sick and weak of Body but of sound Mind and Memory
therefor ^{calling} to mind the Mortality of my Body do make and ordain
this my last will and Testament in the following Manner and
Form Viz. After allowing my Body to be buried in decent and
Christian manner and my Just Debts being paid. I give My son
Andrew A Horse belonging to me he has in the Wagon - I
give unto my son John my son boy Robert I give unto
my Daughter Margaret one Cow I give unto her Child two Sheep
I give unto Mary my wife one third of my Real Estate during
her Natural life and the one third of my remaining Personal
Estate to be disposed of by her at pleasure and the other two
thirds to be equally divided amongst my under named Children
Viz. John Mary Andrew and Henry also the remaining two
thirds of my real Estate and the first third at my wifes
decease I give to my two sons John and Henry to be
equally divided ~~between~~ them having respect to Quantity
and Quality and then my son John is to have the
first share lastly I ordain constitute and appoint my son
John and David Wharney my sole Executors of this my
last will and Testament in witness whereof I have set
my hand and seal this second day of May in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty one
